Dear KHS parents/students,

We hope this letter finds you and your family healthy and ready to begin a new phase of learning for Kingsford High School. Please see the information included below that outlines the Kingsford High School Continuity of Learning Plan summary.

Kingsford High School teachers will provide lessons and materials in a variety of ways. Most lessons will be taught in an online or digital format so students will be able to access the lesson from home. Resources like Google Classroom, Google Meeting Hangouts, Zoom meetings, YouTube Lessons, Schoology, and Khan Academy will be used. Teachers will also provide Continued Learning Resource packets if a student **cannot** participate in an online environment due to device or connectivity issues.

- **Preferred Option 1:** Students participate in the digital or online lessons provided by each teacher and complete the materials associated with the lesson
- **Option 2:** A parent, the student or other family member contact the teacher directly to receive a copy of a learning resource packet that would cover similar materials. These packets could be then printed at your convenience at a location of your choice. This option will support social distancing.
- **Option 3:** Call the Kingsford High School attendance line on Mondays at (906) 779-2670 (press 1). Leave your name, student name, grade level and that you are requesting a learning packet. A packet will be assembled on Tuesday from each teacher. The packets will then be available for pick-up each Wednesday during the designated meal distribution time of 10:00 AM- 12:00 Noon

Since most teachers teach multiple classes with multiple grade levels, the schedule provides for a window of time for all digital meetings.
